Eligibility

- You must be a Canadian citizen, living in Simcoe County, Canada, and 18 years of age or older to participate.
- Artwork Requirements
- Your work must have been created specifically for projects which have been rejected.
- You must work or live in Simcoe County.
- All submitted work must be original, and from your own reference materials.
- No AI-generated images, workshop pieces, or work made under instruction will be accepted.
- All artwork can be available for sale, but it's not required.
- Artists are responsible for shipping sold artwork and obtaining proof of delivery.

Entry Fees

- Fees are non-refundable and must be paid at the time of acceptance.
- Fees: \$40 if accepted

Jurying Process

There are no jurors! Ya!

Submissions will be evaluated based on requirements listed above, and will be on a first-come-first-served. Artistic merit, originality, emotional impact, and how well the piece reflects the theme will be considered.

Dates to Remember

- Accepting submissions: September 1, 2025
- Submission deadline: October 1, 2025
- Notification date: October 6, 2025
- Exhibition dates: November 3-30, 2025

Selected artists will have their work displayed online from November to December 2025.
